### Attribution is still important:

**Why?** Citing the work of other humans is a morally valuable and legally required principle that academia upholds. That principle continues to apply to human writing you use for this class. It also transfers to content generated by generative AI tools. Organizations like the <u>MLA</u> and <u>APA</u> have come up with guidelines on how to cite such content, which we will follow.

#### Responsibility of content is still yours:

**Why?** Generative AI tools can sometimes produce **factually incorrect**, biased, or potentially harmful outputs. As an author, it's your responsibility to verify any content you use from these tools for factual correctness, bias, and potential for social harm.

#### Documentation of your use of AI is key:

**Why?** If asked, you should be able to demonstrate how much of the work was done by you, and what role Al tools played in assisting you. How you choose to demonstrate that is up to you. Some suggestions include sharing transcripts of your ChatGPT chats using the "share" feature, adding statements about Al use at the end
